Conditions and criteria for evaluating the projects applied to the "ENERGO-PRO for Society" initiative:

- 1. The project must be in one of the announced six thematic areas: support of educational initiatives, preservation of the environment, building of ecological values, sustainable development of the urban environment, energy efficiency, safe use of electrical appliances and electrical equipment.
- 2. The project must not just need funding, but form values and attitudes for sustainable change for the benefit of the local and national community.
- 3. The project should benefit the local community and guarantee a long-term effect.
- 4. Preference is given to projects that are innovative and introduce new practices in the respective fields, supported by the "ENERGO-PRO for Society" program.
- 5. The project must achieve its goals in an efficient manner;
- 6. The project should have a specific and measurable result that solves a specific problem.

"ENERGO-PRO for society" does not support:

- Medical treatment of private individuals;
- Projects related to charity;
- The coverage of current obligations of a different nature;
- Projects related to religious or political activity;
- Projects of trade union organizations;
- Projects of business organizations;
- Projects of private individuals;
- Projects that conflict with company policies and procedures.

If the project does not fall within the scope of point 1, the project proposal is not considered.

If the project falls under the cases of point 7, the project proposal is not considered. The criteria for points from 2 to 6 are evaluated with 1 point for their fulfillment.

The final grade for the project is formed after weighting the results with weights as follows and obtaining a final grade as the sum of the weighted grades.
